Attendees of the 16th Annual Hank Snow Tribute held August 17 – 20, 2006 at the South Shore Exhibition Grounds in Bridgewater enjoyed outstanding entertainment by talented musicians from across Canada and the United States. Chet Brown has now won this particular contest four years in a row wearing jackets handmade by his wife Betty Lou.

The 17th Annual Hank Snow Tribute will be held August 16 – 19, 2007 at the South Shore Exhibition Grounds in Bridgewater. The event will take on a different format this year as the 10th Anniversary of the Nova Scotia Country Music Hall of Fame Induction Night will be held **September 15, 2007** at the Wandlyn Inn in Bridgewater, and **not** at the Hank Snow Tribute. We are excited to have George Hamilton IV perform on the Thursday night of the Tribute in 2007. Additional performers for that show will be identified in the Spring 2007 Newsletter.

Lauren attended the *Canadian Country Music Awards* in Saint John in September and made contacts with some of the best-known names in Canada's country music scene. "*They were thrilled to be asked*," she said, "*everyone so far has said yes to our request*."

The memorabilia received to date will be on display for the 2007 season and updated regularly as items come in. **Lauren** says the welcome by these artists is encouraging for the future of the centre and for its expansion plans. Those plans are now the subject of a feasibility study.

While Hank Snow will remain the Centre's main focus, inviting other Canadian country music artists in will help keep the museum evolving and will attract additional local people and tourists to the Centre.






