# Passages

Since our last newsletter, we have lost a few people who have made a significant impact on the Friends of Hank Snow Society and the Hank Snow Country Music Centre.

On January 1, 2006, Smilin' Ivan Dorey passed away at the age of 79. Ivan was a founding director of the Friends of Hank Snow Society and long-time supporter of the Hank Snow Country Music Centre. Even though Ivan was unable to participate as often as he would have liked to, after moving to Halifax, he called before and after every meeting or event, to wish us well and to see how things had gone. Ivan was inducted into the Nova Scotia Country Music Hall of Fame in 2000. There will be a Memorial / Jam Session on Sunday, June 18 at 2:00 pm at the Hank Snow Country Music Centre grounds.

**Frank Carver** passed away January 20, 2006 at the age of 74. Frank was a well-known country musician who performed with his band Classic Country at a number of Hank Snow Tributes, other fundraisers and variety shows. He represented the Friends of Hank Snow Society when he performed a tribute to Hank Snow at the Annual Tulip Festival at the National Arts Centre in Ottawa. He also tied for first place with Chet Brown, in the first Sounds Like Hank Contest at the 5th Annual Hank Snow Tribute in 1995. He competed each year until 1999.

**Dr. Howard Locke** passed away in May 2006. Dr. and Mrs. Locke donated a portion of their property, adjacent to the Hank Snow Country Music Centre, to the Friends of Hank Snow Society in 1991. The combined properties will make it possible to hold larger festivals, accommodate RV parking and will make a great location for hosting community and regional events. A portion of the land was dedicated in 2005 as Great Oak Park, in memory of some of his friends who gave their lives in both World Wars. The Friends of Hank Snow Society are forever indebted to Dr. Locke and his family, for the donation of this property.

#### ROCKET RESTORED

Country legend **Hank Snow**'s former *1939 Chris Craft Commuter*, believed to be one of four produced and the only one still afloat, has gone through an extensive restoration. Lakeside Marine owner **Dan Meals**, said that what began as a touch up quickly became an elaborate process which included re-caulking the entire 41-foot boat. His crew worked between 400-450 hours on restoring the boat for its current owner **Bobby Garrison**, a retired firefighter who bought it from the bank for \$10,000 in 1987.

"The original cost on them was \$38,000 back in 1939. You could buy a house for \$3,500 and a car for \$700 so you can imagine how much money was involved," Garrison said.

"Hank Snow had it named The Golden Rocket after the song and he said he made enough money off that song to buy the boat, that's the story." The Golden Rocket" hit number one in 1950.

Everything on Snow's old boat is original, including the engines, although Garrison had added modern amenities such as air conditioning, a refrigerator and a generator. The mammoth structure is all mahogany and weighs 16 tons.

"Bringing a boat in is similar to going to the dentist, you may have a cavity but you don't know what the extent of the damage is until he gets in there and starts drilling," Meals said of the restoration. "There is infection and disease within the wood or structure of the boat and, until you can uncover it to find out what that is, you don't know what you have. We were going to come in here and sand it down, smooth it up and shoot it with some paint."

The boat's value was estimated at around \$250,000 as far back as 10 years ago but Garrison says he has no plans to sell. "How can you set a price on a one-of-a-kind?" Garrison asked.

Snow had painted the interior mahogany all gold and Garrison has left a small portion of Snow's paint job to help tell the story of The Golden Rocket, now named "Coffee Break."

"When I got the boat it was really rough, a songwriter had been living on it and writing songs, so it has quite a history with the music people. There were several songwriters who were on this boat and unfortunately I don't know who they were," Garrison said.

Garrison said he has always wanted to take the boat to New Orleans and now that it is restored he is planning that trip soon.






